- 3. Jesus is born in Bethlehem
- 4. Adoration of the shepherds
- 5. Circumcision and giving Jesus his name
- Adoration of the three kings
- Presentation of Jesus at the Temple
 Holy Family's flight to Egypt
- 9. Holy Family's flight to Egypt
- 10. Holy Family's return to Nazareth
- 11. Jesus' quiet life in Nazareth
- The Child Jesus in the Temple among teachers and Scripture scholars

ROSARY TO THE INFANT JESUS APPROVED BY THE HOLY FATHER PIUS IX

Among the devotions in honor of the miraculous Infant Jesus of Prague, there is not a more suitable one than the little rosary to the Infant Jesus. We were entrusted with this devotion by sister Margaret of the Most Precious Sacrament, a Carmelite nun. This worthy daughter of St. Theresa with a saintly reputation died in 1648, when she was only 27 years old. She became known for her devotion to the Infant Jesus and for spreading it among the faithful.

Inspired by above, she gave us a rosary that consists of three Our Fathers in honor of the Holy Family and 12 Hail Marys in honor of the first 12 years of Jesus' childhood. Jesus revealed to his faithful admirer how the spread of this devotion was dear to him. In one of her visions, he showed her the little rosary on which the tiny beads were shining with supernatural light. He promised her that those who carry and with devotion pray this rosary will safeguard their purity and innocence.

While sister Margaret was still alive, many miraculous spiritual and temporal graces were granted to those who were praying this rosary.

The Infant Jesus with joy hears the prayers of the souls who pray this rosary and royally rewards those who spread this devotion. Here is one out of thousands of such cases. A person already in an older age came down with several different illnesses, especially rheumatic ones. She was almost immobile. As she was used to be always on to go from her childhood, she had a tough time accepting the new reality. One day, while she was in great pain, she was visited by her nephew, who was a priest. She asked if he could help her in some way. He advised her to put all her trust in the Infant Jesus of Prague. "That Divine Child, he said, is making marvelous miracles at this time in particular. Pray everyday this rosary with a firm faith because devotion to the Divine Infant has immeasurable power."

Because of this, the good lady began to pray the rosary in hope that she would be heard soon and that her pains would go away. She did not have to wait too long for divine grace. Already the next day she felt a change in her legs and was so mobile that she could climb the stairs.

Needless to say, this lady witnessed her great thankfulness to the Divine Benefactor by praying every day the rosary that helped her to be healed. All the people who knew about her paralysis, after witnessing the graces she had received, also began to pray this rosary in their needs, putting their trust in the miraculous Infant Jesus of Prague. Sister Margaret recommended that all carry and pray this rosary of the Infant Jesus as a sign of the greatness and innocence of Jesus in the crib, and as a firm link that connects us with him.

In the prayer that a priest utters during the blessing of this rosary, he says:

Lord, protect all those who carry this rosary in honor of the 12 years of the holy childhood of Jesus, from every spiritual and bodily evil, free them from sin, and help them constantly to grow and stay in your love. By your grace, let them be worthy to enter into eternal life. Amen.

Let this rosary be prayed with piety and faith, especially on Mondays, when we celebrate the Infant Jesus of Prague, and on the 25th day of every month because that is the

day of the glorious Incarnation and Birth of God's Son. "That day is celebrated because of the vast graces that the Divine Child in his self-giving has bestowed upon us" said Blessed Sister Margaret of the Most Precious Sacrament.
